



**Statement of Work
for
Matagorda Island: Mesquite Point and Outer Rim Culvert Replacement**

**Addendum 2 (July 9, 2010)
to
Statement of Work dated June 21, 2010**

The following changes are hereby made to the Statement of Work for Matagorda Island: Mesquite Point and Outer Rim Culvert Replacement.

- 1) **At the Mesquite Point project site, culvert length is changed to 40'** (instead of 20'). This change applies to all references in the Statement of Work that relate to culvert size and/or installation. Such references include (but are not limited to) section 2.1 (Steel, Lumber Vinyl, and Culvert Materials), section 3.4 (Culvert Installation), and the Table of Items.
- 2) **At the Outer Rim project site, culvert length is changed to 30'** (instead of 20'). This change applies to all references in the Statement of Work that refer to culvert size and/or installation. Such references include (but are not limited to) section 2.1 (Steel, Lumber Vinyl, and Culvert Materials), section 3.4 (Culvert Installation), and the Table of Items.
- 3) If possible, **each culvert shall consist of a single pipe of the needed length** (Contractor shall not achieve the needed length by joining shorter pipes). If Contractor must utilize and join shorter pipes to achieve the needed length, a statement to that effect shall be included with Contractor's Bid Sheet. This change applies to all references in the Statement of Work that refer to culvert size and/or installation. Such references include (but are not limited to) section 2.1 (Steel, Lumber Vinyl, and Culvert Materials), section 3.4 (Culvert Installation), and the Table of Items.
- 4) Stockpiles or an onsite borrow source for soil materials may be up to 5 miles from the project site (instead of up to 2.5 miles). This change applies to all references in the Statement of Work as that relate to onsite borrow sources. Such references include (but are not limited to) section 2.2 (Soil and Riprap Materials).
- 5) In section 3.2 (Transportation), "Darkwater Barge Company" is removed from the list of local companies that may provide barge services, and "Brown Water Marine Services" is added to the list.
- 6) The following section is added to the Statement of Work.

3.9. Demobilization and Clean-Up

Contractor shall remove all equipment, supplies, construction debris, excavation debris, and trash produced by the described Work (or other operations of the Contractor) off of Matagorda Island and Aransas National Wildlife Refuge property, and shall properly dispose of any items as needed.
