- Funds Awarded: **\$1,500,000**

### **CIAP – 2008 Grant Cycle**

#### **Matagorda Island Marsh Restoration**

- Objective: Implement Adaptive Management Plan Action Items designed to restore circulation through Matagorda Island's 15,000 acre Western Marsh. Action Items
- Funds Awarded: **\$700,000**

#### **Nueces Bay Causeway Marsh Restoration**

- Objective: Restore marsh lost to the construction of the Nueces Bay Causeway/U.S. Highway 181.
- Funds Awarded: **\$839,000**
