- I. Welcome. Meeting called to order at 2:07 p.m. All attendees present introduced themselves
  
- II. Shamrock Island – Bob Corrigan’s concerns, voiced in the last Board of Director’s Meeting, regarding the priority status being placed solely on the Shamrock Island project (almost to the exclusion of all else) were explained to the Coordination Team for their input. The general consensus was that the Shamrock Island project is indeed a priority, among others, but that the Coordination Team also needs to conceptualize and prioritize a list of regional ecological ‘dream’ projects to have available when such mitigation opportunities arise (instead of reacting to the proposals of others).
  
- III. Vista Del Sol LNG Facility and Mitigation

ExxonMobil presented their BU and Mitigation Plan to the group for consideration. After much discussion, the group’s main concerns pertaining to the Plan were:

1. The loss of so much deepwater habitat in exchange for so little planted shallow habitat.
2. Resulting water clarity and water depth (or possible lack thereof).
3. Resulting impact to shrimping and fishing in the Bay (human use).

Rocky Freund made the motion that all CBBEP Teams should review the proposed Plan and provide the Coordination Team with their recommendations,

comments, and concerns in time to provide public comment (before February 7, 2005). The motion was seconded by Beau Hardegree and passed unanimously.
